If you like the Air Force Enlisted Village, aka Bob Hope Village, as a neighbor, you will be pleased with the planned development of Victory Village. Last summer we completed the purchase of 80 acres of land from Eglin AFB and our plan is to develop a sister community which will help joint service enlisted retirees and spouses as well as be a home for wounded warriors as they age. We are in the early phases of zoning and future land use map updates with Okaloosa County and we're also looking at what additional community services and infrastructure will be needed for our neighborhood. We are already working on adding additional sewer capacity along with a larger water main which will benefit everyone with more water pressure! We have also allocated space on the property for a small EMS station to be operated by Ocean City Wright Fire Department. If you have any questions or concerns, please let us know. 
TRUNK OR TREAT

Minutes of the October 6th, 2025 meeting

Meeting called to order at 18:00 (by Michael Aid)

Present: Michael and Tammi Aid, Felicia Murphy, David Boyd, Tricia Flaherty, Bob Davis, Mary Ann Leone, Pam Martin, Nance Wendell, Mary and Kenny Travis, Jef Marsh, Nancy and Steve Ellison, Julene Hasty, Carla Hunt, Ryan Voisard, and Lendy Edwards.

<u>Minutes</u> of the September meeting had been distributed; motion to approve was made by Bob and seconded by Nance, minutes were approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Treasurer's reports for September was presented by Tricia. Income was \$20.00 and expenses were \$510.94. Total funds are \$10,445.80 and available funds (not obligated) are \$8,684.85. The report was approved after a motion by David, seconded by Mary Ann. Tricia also presented a draft budget for 2026, which was reviewed, and should be approved at the General Membership meeting, with time for changes in the interim.

Old Business: The General Membership meeting is planned for 23 October, at 1800 (program to start at 1830), at BHEV (Gates Building at Sunset entrance), with guest speaker CMSgt (ret) Brooke McLean, President of AFEV, discussing growth of AFEV. After his presentation, votes for election of officers and budget will be taken. Two important openings are for two VP positions, since Carla has volunteered to run for Corresponding Secretary, and Felicia has volunteered to run for President. Refreshments will be provided by PBCA (up to \$250) under the direction of Mary and Pam.

New Business: Trunk or Treat will be held Friday 31 October at Leo Norred Park, from 1700-1900. The neighborhood garage sale will be held 08-09 November (Saturday principal, Sunday rain date), and Nance (POC) already has supplies. The Veterans Day Ceremony is tentatively set for 11 November at 1600. Friendsgiving is scheduled for 22 November at 1600. Tricia has volunteered to host the PBCA storage shed instead of a more vulnerable position in the park. A motion was made by David and seconded by Mary Anny to approve the new location. Pam will head a committee to consider a sign or signs designating Leo Norred Park; she was appointed after a motion by David and second by Mike.

Committee Reports: No reports (by exception) due to discussions regarding upcoming events.

Announcements: Newsletter articles for next newsletter due to Tammi Aid by 12 October. Next PBCA board meeting scheduled for 1800, Monday, 03 November, location Leone Residence, 30 Poquito.

Meeting adjourned 18:59 pm.
