

### Minutes of the 2024 Annual General Membership Meeting Leo Norred Park, Shalimar, 26 October 2024, 1600

CALL TO ORDER (1602): Sean Cramer, President

He opened a discussion on PBCA current issues. Recent improvements have been made to the park, including removal of broken tables, which will need replacements going forward. A new sign will also be required due to decay. The Veterans Monument will be advanced to include 20 new poles with the names of neighborhood Veterans.

#### General Membership Meeting Agenda:

- Michael Aid discussed proposed changes to the Bylaws to include elimination of the positions for Assistant Treasurer and Junior Board members, and adding the positions of Editor (Poquito Times) and Membership Chair. The changes also clarified non-voting members (those desiring membership but living outside the defined boundaries. The second signature requirement for checks was eliminated, and an Audit will be conducted at the beginning of each year. A motion to approve was made by Michael and seconded by me (David). The motion passed unanimously.
- 2025 PBCA Budget Tricia Bryant-Flaherty gave a brief PBCA Treasurer's Report and presented the proposed 2025 PBCA Budget for approval by voting members, which was approved unanimously.
- c. Board Members/Street Directors elections Sean presented the slate of candidates of Board Members and Street Directors elections for a vote by PBCA members, with no new volunteers. Bob Davis moved for approval, with a second by Michael Aid, and the motion passed unanimously.
- d. Discussions were held on potential park improvements (such as workout stations, as well as disaster preparedness, including the CERT program. A spreadsheet for members in need could be helpful. Sophie Beedie volunteered to help. Mary Trevis volunteered to be a Street Director.
- f. Attendance: Sean and Whitney Cramer, Michael and Tammi Aid, Ken and Mary Ann Leone, Tricia Flaherty, Felicia Murphy, Bob Davis, David Boyd, Sophie Beedie, Jeff Marsh, Carla Hunt, Deb Henderson, Phyllis Seymour, and Mary Travis.

The meeting was adjourned at 1630.
