Poquito Bayou and Longwood Cats and Kittens

For neighbors not on our Facebook page, we wanted you to be aware of a wonderful ongoing project.

Cats, kittens, everywhere! Well, maybe not everywhere, but the feral feline population in Poquito Bayou and Longwood has been growing. A very kind and generous animal lover and neighbor, Brenda Armacost, partnered with the Okaloosa Animal Protection League (APL) and Crossroads Animal Clinic to get our colony under control. Brenda traps the cats overnight, the following morning takes them to Crossroads for surgery, then takes them to her home for the night, and releases them the following morning where they were trapped. In addition to neutering/spaying, the cats are also given a rabies shot, flea/tick prevention, microchip, and a tipped ear so they can be easily identified. As of mid February, our neighborhood has 32 cats that will no longer be reproducing.

All of this would not have been possible without Brenda spearheading the project and generous donations from our community, APL, and Crossroads. APL donated \$50 per cat for our first 30 cats, and donations from our community funded the remainder. The project is now completely our financial responsibility. Crossroads will continue the surgeries at shelter pricing—males are \$87, females \$98.

If you have questions or a feral cat that needs neutered/spayed, please text or call Brenda at 850-357-3542. Donations of any amount will be greatly appreciated so we can continue this fantastic project. You can donate directly to Crossroads, 850-586-7696 (there is a fee for using a credit card), drop off a check or cash at Crossroads, 601B Eglin Pkwy (beside Batteries Plus), or Brenda will pick up a check at your home (payable to Crossroads). Minutes of the February 3rd, 2025 meeting

Meeting called to order at 18:00 (by Sean Cramer)

Present: Sean and Whitney Cramer, Felicia Murphy, Bob Davis, David Boyd, Tricia Flaherty, Nance Wendell, Pam Martin, Mary Travis, Mary Ann Leone, Michael and Tammi Aid.

Minutes of the January meeting had been distributed; motion to approve was made by Mike and seconded by Nance, minutes were approved. Bob asked for clarification on sign nomenclature. The neighborhood sign will also be called the entry sign.

Old Business: The board discussed signs for most of the meeting. The entry sign will be repaired by Kevin from World of Signs, who described the process. The sign will be away for two weeks or more. Mike made a motion to allow Kevin to make this repair, Bob seconded, and it passed unanimously. The plan is to have separate signs designating Leo Norred Park and the Poquito Bayou Veteran's Monument. Kevin brought some materials to show some of the options, with aluminum being far out of the price range of PBCA. After discussion, the group decided to pursue the poly-AL product with acrylic letters, and Kevin will produce quotes for the two signs. The group agreed to a framed brown park sign without cutouts for the park sign, 3x2 ft. The monument sign will match the plaques in shape and style. Ken Leone has the rails/posts for the park fence, and they have been paid for. Felicia reported that a class project will result in the donation of at least 3 new picnic tables for Leo Norred Park. The Abandoned Homes Committee is monitoring houses that are not being cared for due to aging owners in facilities. Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's report for January was presented by Tricia. Income was \$168.81 and expenses were \$595.30 (including the rails). Total funds are \$9,320.47 and available funds (not obligated) are \$6,808.53. She noted that Felicia managed to put on the entire Christmas children's celebration for just \$112.17. The report was approved after a motion by Pam and second by Felicia. Membership: Pam reported at least a dozen membership forms have been received for 2025. BHEV: Bob reported the Brook McClain would be willing to meet and explain Victory Village. Poquito Boat Ramp Park: No current issues reported, per Sean who visits regularly, including in snow. Street & Traffic Safety: Bob reported some slight repairs of road edges since our last meeting. Street Directors: Felicia plans to have a meeting within the next month. Mary Travis serves Magnolia. New Business: The Spring Boil is scheduled for 08 March, and the Easter Egg Hunt is scheduled for 12 April. The garage sale will be held 26-27 April. The County Commission voted on 07 January to move forward with the Eglin Orphan Parcels development.

<u>Announcements</u>: Newsletter articles for next newsletter due to Tammi Aid by 11 February. Next PBCA board meeting scheduled 1800 on Monday, 03 March, at the Martin home, 17 Magnolia.

Meeting adjourned at 18:58 pm.
