If you like the Air Force Enlisted Village, aka Bob Hope Village, as a neighbor, you will be pleased with the planned development of Victory Village. Last summer we completed the purchase of 80 acres of land from Eglin AFB and our plan is to develop a sister community which will help joint service enlisted retirees and spouses as well as be a home for wounded warriors as they age. We are in the early phases of zoning and future land use map updates with Okaloosa County and we're also looking at what additional community services and infrastructure will be needed for our neighborhood. We are already working on adding additional sewer capacity along with a larger water main which will benefit everyone with more water pressure! We have also allocated space on the property for a small EMS station to be operated by Ocean City Wright Fire Department. If you have any questions or concerns, please let us know. Meeting called to order at 18:00 (by Michael Aid)

Present: Michael Aid, David Boyd, Tricia Flaherty, Bob Davis, Mary Ann Leone, Pam Martin, Nance Wendell, Mary Travis, and Lendy Edwards.

New Business: The future of the organization was discussed, with a list produced and distributed by Bob to show the contributions that the organization makes to the community. These include maintaining and improving the park, neighborhood garage sales, Easter Egg Hunts, Halloween events (e.g. Trunk or Treat), Christmas Parade, Friendsgiving, Veteran's Day Service, Candidates night, decorations, Yard of the Month contests, and coordination with local officials of various agencies. The organization is in desperate need of new volunteers and board members, and especially a new President. Mike will send out (via email, Facebook, and newsletter) a plea to the neighborhood for volunteers to keep the association alive and functioning, with general agreement by all present.

<u>Minutes</u> of the August meeting had been distributed; motion to approve was made by Mary and seconded by Pam, minutes were approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Treasurer's reports for August was presented by Tricia. Income was \$40.00 and expenses were \$283.46. Total funds are \$10,936.74 and available funds (not obligated) are \$9,175.79. The report was approved after a motion by Pam, seconded by Bob.

Old Business: The Veterans Monument sign is complete and is awaiting placement until after the new posts are in place and painted. The General Membership meeting has been set for 23 October, at 1800 (program to start at 1830), at BHEV, with guest speaker CMSgt (ret) Brooke McLean, President of AFEV, discussing growth of AFEV. Trunk or Treat will be held Sunday 26 October at Leo Norred Park, with Mary Ann as POC. The neighborhood garage sale will be held 08-09 November (Saturday principal, Sunday rain date), with Nance as POC. The Veterans Day Ceremony is tentatively set for 11 November at 1600.

Committee Reports: No reports due to discussions regarding the future of PBCOA.

<u>Announcements</u>: Newsletter articles for next newsletter due to Tammi Aid by 12 September. Next PBCA board meeting scheduled for 1800, Monday, 06 October, location TBD.
